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Beech Springs Farm celebrated its' third and last dinner of their 3-part series of Farm to Table Dinners on Sunday, Sept. 20.

The unique event showcased and celebrated the region's offerings through a multi-course meal prepared by Chef Josh Fidler.

Chef Josh is well known for his upscale rustic culinary style, and creative approach to developing seasonal dishes, which incorporate the seasonal bounty of local fields, orchards and pastures.

The evening was enhanced by the live jazz music of the Pomona's Trio. The trio, comprised of Brett Crawford, saxophone; Marc Jalbert, guitar and Lisa Cadigan, vocals, have been performing together at area venues since 2012.

Since Beech Springs Farm introduced its Farm To Table Dinner Series in early 2015, each of the three events have been sold out.

Jayne Shord, CSA Farmer, announced that beginning in 2016 they will be offering a 6-part Farm To Table Dinner series the second Sunday of each month, from May through October. Each dinner will be uniquely different and include entertainment from local artists.

Appropriately named the "Second Sunday Suppers," the dinners will once again, feature top chefs from our surrounding area and focus on incorporating the farm's fresh vegetables, herbs and honey. The dinners will incorporate products from other Adams County farms and vineyards as well.
